





Breaking the Language Barrier: Literacy Logic English Second Language Student Excels in Reading and Handwriting



According to data from the National Center of Education Statistics, the percentage of public-school students in the United States who are English Second Language (ESL) learners has increased to 10.4 % or 5.1 million students. ESL students struggle to comprehend text and lack foundational reading skills due to not understanding English. 


Breyden using the concepts of print strategies to read his book during independent reading time.

When Breyden first enrolled in the Rocket Reader program, he was unable to consistently read English text and struggled with writing.

The Rocket Reader program focused on building Breyden's foundational skills in reading and handwriting. He learned concepts of print, phonemic awareness and vocabulary building strategies. Breyden learned how to become a more confident reader and loves to read books independently now. His handwriting has improved with the formation of letters and spacing techniques. Breyden is now on grade level in reading and writing. He continues show more confidence in his abilities.
